





The parade through town and the show and shine in a park each year is calculated to bring enjoyment to both the **CORVAIR** owners and the on-lookers, plus the shopping and different restaurants in these towns are always a treat. It is always enjoyable to look forward to meeting the friends you made last year and be able to talk with the people who live in the towns that we use. Many of those folks owned **CORVAIRS** themselves and it brings back fond memories of another time.



GET READY FOR SUMMER TRAVEL

Hopefully this summer will see a lot of PPCC members driving their CORVAIRS. This will include the drive to Salida in early June and then to Reno/Lake Tahoe later in the month. June will not be the hottest month of the year but across the top of Utah and through Nevada the temperatures can soar quickly. Add to that the fact that not too many towns exist in some of those areas and it becomes a fact that you had better have your CORVAIR well prepared for these trips.

TIRES: Look at all four tires on the ground and check the tread. If there are unusual wear patterns, now is the time to get the alignment done and get new tires on the car. Also check the spare, both for condition and just how much air is in it. Flat tires do not occur like they used to and the spare is often neglected. Also make a practice of checking the air pressure on a regular basis, both around town and when you are on the highway. Talking about flats, can you put your hands on the jack and lug wrench easily?? How about if you have mag wheels, do you have regular lug nuts for the spare?? The mag lug nuts will not fit well on a stock steel wheel.

FLUID LEVELS AND LUBRICATION: When did you check your master cylinder, differential and transmission grease and lubed the front suspension?? How about the grease in the steering box?? You might as well check the windshield washer fluid too although most of us in this area keep the washer stuff up anyway. The increased heat of driving on the highway at sustained speeds for hours will weed out those transaxles that have been neglected. Likewise any other bearing such as the wheel bearings will get more use, remember the car is loaded with luggage so the bearings are carrying more load than usual. Grease the ball joints/tie rod ends before leaving, once again, the extra load you are placing in the trunk will only cause more wear if this stuff is left out of the maintainance program. The highest priority in this program should be oil/filter changes in the engine. Don't make your engine work overtime pulling you faithfully over mountain passes and flat desert highways by leaving dirty oil in it.

BRAKES/LIGHTS/ACCESSORIES: Naturally you will already know if the brakes on your car need attention and obviously this is one of the most important parts of the car; your brakes need to work perfectly every time. Along with that, the other parts of the suspension need to work in harmony too. If your tires were worn (see above), do you need ball joints, suspension bushings, other steering work? A lot of us like to drive at night, others just get caught after dark trying to get to the next town. Like I said above, it can be a fair drive between two towns in Nevada and the headlights and tail lights should be very good. Halogen headlamps give a much stronger light than the old T-3 that came on the car. Even your dash lights are important when driving in the desert, the monotony can be very dangerous to your health and improper interior lighting can play havoc on your eyes after looking at the dash for hours at a time. A good CB radio and/or cell phone is a must when driving in some of these desolate areas as well as a regular FM radio and maybe some tapes to keep you going. If you are a stranger to these areas, a good map is essential although a laptop with a GPS is even better.

TOOLS/SPARE PARTS: A good flashlight or maybe even a couple of them are well needed at night plus a light that can utilize the car battery is good too. The normal hand tools are all that are required and maybe jumper cables. Spare parts should include a couple of fan belts, idler pulley, oil pressure switch, fuel pump, points, spare fuses, electrical tape and a few feet of wire and some fuel line and extra clamps. Also one of the 12Volt air compressors are handy and you could add a tubeless tire repair kit then. Also remember that the desert turns cold at night; jackets, sweaters and even gloves are handy to have plus a quilt/blanket or two. Also a small ice cooler with a couple of cans of soft drink or water and some cookies etc will not take up much space. If you had to stop for a few hours for any reason, some norishment is handy to have.

I am sure each of you can think of things I have forgotten. Just be prepared for a few unexpected situations in case. I would rather carry all of the above and not need any of it than to NEED it and find that I left it at home.

Several other club members come to my mind: Bill Reider and Sylvan Zuecher who worked on CORVAIRS for a long time before retiring, Chuck Vertrees and Wendell Walker also have attended many of the same meets as some of us. TECH TIP (rust prevention)

After 2 1/2 years of looking for all the water leaks into the trunk of my 63, I found water was also coming in from UNDER the fender area. You can check this by using a mirror, looking up underneath a front corner of the trunk. I suggest also that you remove the front tires, get a flashlight and a mirror and luck up toward the back side of the headlights, then toward the trunk to make sure the small area about 3" wide x 1" high x 3" deep that goes toward the trunk is free of rust and dirt. Wire brushing, scraping, sanding and using the air hose hopefully cleaned the area on my car. Then after the use of EXTEND and JB WELD (to patch and plug the holes), it's paint time and then back to the car wash to see if there are any more leaks.

Got that done???Now follow the seam all the way back to the door. Do you want to know why the areas under the trunk gasket rusted??I suspenct it came up from the bottom.

A NEW IDEA TO GET MEMBERS

I wrote an article in the **DENVAIR NEWS (Denver)** last month, an idea to help get new members in our clubs and of course want to share it with **PPCC** also. Here is how it works: **FIRST**, we need a membership packet (for the lack of a better description). Included is a contact card which we just got last meeting, a description of **PPCC** and the activities we are involved in and a sample **DRIPLINE** and also **COMMUNIQUE**. We then need some volunteers in different areas of C/Springs to watch the newspaper advertisements, when the volunteer sees an ad in their area then they call the seller of the car and make a drive over to check out the car. The volunteer offers the packet to the seller with the request that the packet be passed to the new buyer. To bribe the seller into taking care of this, **PPCC** offers a free ad in the **DRIPLINE** to help sell the car.

Now I realize that we **(PPCC)** now charge non-members for the line ads and we can continue to do this if it comes from out of the C/Springs metro area through the mail. The above would only apply to metro Springs. I would imagine the dues money for the year would offset the price of an advertisement too.

I think that there are a couple of benefits to the above description. First I imagine that some new buyers don't even know that a local club exists, if they do hear the rumor, the packet will reinforce their notion that **PPCC** is a viable club and doing things with our cars. There also might be a chance that when the seller discovers a club in the area, the car may come off the market and be enjoyed by the old owner again. The second benefit is that the volunteers get to chase after all the cars and discover the bargains that sometimes exist. The only thing that the volunteer is out is a little gas and some time driving around but I know a lot of us do that already.

There is one other factor that **PPCC** should address, that of membership into **CORSA**. If you notice above, I include a sample **COMMUNIQUE** with the packet. **CORSA** will furnish extra copies quite willingly, they send me a box to the shop whenever I request it. I will take a pretty firm stand however that we change our membership requirements: any new member (after whatever date we decide) **MUST JOIN CORSA** also. **RMC** has had this rule in their constitution since their beginning and **PPCC** should follow suit. For any member now on our roster that is not a member of **CORSA**, the mandatory paragraph will not apply so if you don't belong now you don't have join to stay a member of **PPCC**. I might suggest a stipulation that if a person's dues expire or they drop out and then rejoin, then they must follow the rules of a new member.

If we get enough members at the May 26th meeting, possibly this could be a topic of discussion, why don't you make an effort to attend???

TIPS TO HELP SELL YOUR CORVAIR

Sooner or later, most car owners are faced with having to part with their cars. Sometimes they have actually bought the car for that purpose, resell and then acquire another and so on, sometimes they are forced to move and can't take the car with them and sometimes they just plain tire of what they have and want a change. For those of you reading this of course, you are wanting to sell a 'special interest' collectable automobile, *not* just another car. You expect more money because this collectable car has been appreciating through the years plus 'THEY JUST DON'T MAKE THEM LIKE THIS ANYMORE'. So you spend money on ads in the Rocky Mountain News/Denver Post/Gazette-Telegraph and have placed a high price your prized possession; let the phone start ringing. Now when the prospective buyer first sees the car, that impression will burn in his memory, either a good impression of 'WOW, that is a nice clean car' or 'where is that high priced collectors car I called about, all I see is this junker".

This impression will at least partially be governed by how the car is presented. If it is sitting under a tree, covered with leaves, bird stuff and has grass growing up by the tires, it is a pretty sure bet you will not convince him that it took first place last weekend at the local car show. So let's say you gave it a shower at the quarter car wash and have it sitting on the drive way, how does it sit on the driveway?? One tire needing air doesn't give the appearance that the car is cared for either. Does the chrome all shine? Just because you washed the car doesn't mean the chrome is ready. Actually the first part of that question should have been "Is all the trim on the car?" If you have advertised this car a a 1969 convert, one of 521 built, for only \$5000.00; this sounds pretty impressive. If the wheel well trim is missing or the grill is gone, how do you expect the new buyer to assess the car?

Ok, lets say the outside has been cleaned up and all the trim is in place, usually the woman will look at the interior next, the man will look at the engine bay. Did you vacuum the interior, clean the seats with 409 or whatever to get the dirt off and make them shiney? How about the glass, is the windshield so smoke stained that it looks foggy when you peer through it? Did you empty the ash tray and clean out the glove box and under the seats? Now while the woman is trying to decide if she really likes the color of the seats, the man has yanked open the engine lid and what should he find there?? Is the top of the engine clean, degreased, maybe repainted (using a good matching engine enamel and *NOT* painting the fuel lines, wiring harness and carbs? How about the battery posts, it is so easy to leave corroded cables in place and once again, it shows a lack of attention to the maintainance of the car in the past. When the buyer pulls the dipstick out of the engine is it black or clear??

Now if the car you are trying to sell lacks in any of these areas, you are hard pressed to ask the price guide prices for it, don't you agree? How can you claim that this 66 turbo convert is worth \$8000 when it looks like you just bailed it out of junk yard? On the other side of the coin, if you are looking at a car that is represented to be a well maintained 'classic' that is worth lots of money and you see all the bad stuff that I just described, are you still going to pay the high price for it knowing that there is work to be done that is visible to your eye and in the back of your mind you should be wondering how much more will there be once I get started on it?







NEW PPCC MEMBERS MUST JOIN CORSA

At the May 26 meeting it was decided that all new PPCC members must also join CORSA. Any current member who DOES NOT belong to CORSA will be 'grandfathered' however there was a stipulation that if the membership dues lapsed for any of those members, then they must also join CORSA when they rejoin PPCC.

Most CHAPTER clubs around the country already have the rule in place. A large part of the reason for joining CORSA is two fold. The first part is simply to support the parent organization that we (PPCC) stem. Your reward in doing this is receiving the COMMUNIQUE every month which is an award winning magazine, filled with tech tips, owners stories, calendar of events and classified ads.

The second part is this: when an event is held such as the Tri-State in Salida, CORSA provides an insurance policy to protect us from the evils of litigation. Things such as damage to the parking lot, park areas where the show and shine are held as well as even the meetings are only a part of what the insurance covers. It also covers moving events such as the econo-runs, gymkhanas, autocross and even parades.

An explanation about the 'grandfather' clause: if you are now a current member of PPCC, you are NOT REQUIRED to join CORSA. However, if your membership is allowed to expire, upon renewal you must join CORSA at the same time. Current CORSA dues are \$35.00/year.

President Garrie Fox is preparing the membership packets to be used when a car is found 'for sale' to pass on to the new owner. Inside this packet will be a copy of the DRIPLINE, COMMUNIQUE as well as applications for both organizations and a cover letter telling the new owner about PPCC.

Hopefully the idea of chasing the classified ads in the newspapers will bring us some new members as well as seeing some new cars for sale in the DRIPLINE.

PLEASE NOTE: Call either Garrie Fox or Ben Benzel and let them know you are coming. Sometimes the tables and chairs get a little close together because the count that the organizer has is less than those attending.

EARLY PREPS FOR WINTER

Cold weather has a habit of sneaking up quickly around here, one day it is t-shirt weather and the next morning is snow and freezing temps. While the weather is still pretty good, you might check a few things on your CORVAIR if you are going to drive it through the winter. Oil change, plugs and points, battery connections, turn on your heater motor, look at the heater hoses and thermostat doors and check your lights, wiper blades and washer pump and fluid level; do them now, it takes only a little time especially to just look at the listed items and make a note to buy whatever looks poor. You might listen to the starter motor too, does it sound as good as last year??if not, better look into it now instead of when it is 20 below zero and the car won't start. If you use all-season tires, look at the tread now, places like DISCOUNT TIRE give good prices for tires during the summer and fall and can get your car in quickly. Once winter sets in the prices go up and the waiting time is longer too.

Going to store your car for winter???if you are simply going to stop driving it while the roads are bad, just fill up the fuel tank and maybe give it a good bath and you can let the car sit for a month or two with no ill effects. HOWEVER if you are not going to touch the car for 6 months, you should add something to that full fuel tank to help keep the gasoline alive, disconnect your battery, put something in or around your car to keep mice away and cover the car with something soft. Hopefully you are putting the car inside a garage but if it is sitting under a carport be careful of the car cover, make sure it is NOT waterproof. If it IS WATERPROOF, it must be removed from the car and allowed to dry out plus let the car 'breathe'. If not, condensation will form between the paint and the cover and really bad things will happen to your paint.

October 31 will be the day that **PPCC** has a chance to celebrate the beginning of the **CORVAIR**. On that date in 1959, the first **CORVAIR** automobiles were viewed by the public in **CHEVROLET** showrooms around the country.

In those days, it was almost a family affair to journey to the **GM** dealership in your area to look at the changes and new designs that **CHEVROLET** was going to offer that particular year. Those of us who did wait impatiently for that date to come can remember the feelings as the new model changes appeared. Sadly in 1999 I don't think the feeling remains, too many look-a-likes and too many models to chose from.

In 1958 the car magazines started writing articles about the new 'compact' cars that **FORD**, **GM** and **CHRYSLER** were planning for the 60's. Of course the Falcon and Valiant/Lancer were the more normal cars, front engine/rear wheel drive; just smaller in size. The auto writers had a field day writing about the advantages/disadvantages of air cooling, rear engine design and even just using aluminum for the basis of an engine. The instant comparison to VW was apparent also, even **GM** was wanting to call the car 'the American VW'.



WINTERTIME PROJECTS

Fall/winter is upon us. It snowed here on Saturday and in my way of thinking has killed our ability to easily climb into a nice car for a drive, there is too much sand/debris on the road as well as goofy drivers.

So-o-o-o, what can we do? Get the car ready for next year, that's it!!! Start looking at improvements you would like for the car. How about things to help the comfort of driving: new seats (especially high back recliners). The new cars have the most comfortable seats you will every find and they are laying around in wrecking yards just waiting to be installed in your CORVAIR. A new steering wheel is a good idea for some. A study a few years ago found that the large steering wheels installed in our cars were WAY TOO BIG. Of course the size was used because it gave better leverage to turn the wheel but if your arms are spread too far to the sides, that is tiring after sitting behind the wheel for a few hours. The study concluded that a wheel no larger than the width of your rib cage is appropriate. Let's face it too, a new soft padded wheel or a nostalgic appearing wood wheel will do wonders to the appearance of your car. From little things like a set of floor mats to big things like radio/CD players, there is always something to do on the interior.

Now let's look at the outside appearance. Naturally wheels is the first item to consider. There are absolutely tons of new style wheels out there and whether you own early/late/fc, there are fancy and artful wheels to fit your car. Wheels are the foremost appearance change you can do to your car and in lots of cases at a reasonable price too. Again, look in wrecking yards or used wheel dealers for a nice set. There are little things that you can add too, such as new tail lite lenses, bumper guards (a GM accessory), gas door guard, running/fog lights or any chrome parts that have suffered the ravages of weather or careless parking lot attendants.

The underside of the car is usually where attention is most needed and least given. I believe it is because after spending all kinds of money on suspension, no one can see the results; but the driver can sure feel the difference. Winter is a good time to lay the car up and replace ball joints, shocks, add quick steering, a steering dampner as well as just cleaning up the underside of the car.

Also while the car is resting in the warmth of your garage you can spend some time lubricating the door hinges, latches, cleaning up the rubber weatherstrips, giving the carpet a good vacuuming, making sure the uphostery is still intact, detail the trunk and/or engine bays and that sort of thing. It will help keep your car in tip top shape for next year and looking good at the same time.

OR YOU CAN THINK BIGGER

Start on your next project. The first word of advice is: tell your wife BEFORE you start OR be sure you can continue to lie good enough to fool her for a long time.

There are project cars advertised in the DRIPLINE occasionally and certainly in your local newspapers. Just be sure before you drag a non-running and usually ugly car home with you that this is the car you want to restore. Nothing is worse than getting part way through a project and either discovering that the car is virtually non-repairable or that you have lost interest.

If all else fails on those cold winter nights, dig out old issues of the COMMUNIQUE and/or other car magazines and re-read and look at the pictures. Sometimes you can get ideas from seeing what someone else has already done. WORD OF CAUTION: DO NOT compare the price of parts and cars between now and a few years back.


BIRTHDAY DRIVE



GIFT IDEAS (FOR THE CORVAIR OWNER WHO DOES NOT HAVE EVERYTHING)

Christmas is right around the corner, with the crass commercialism of today, by the time you read this there will be decorations in the stores and a Santa on every corner. It is easy to buy things to wear, stuff for the house and even things for the yard but every wife needs to know that the GARAGE needs 'goodies' too.

STOCKING STUFFERS???a set of screwdrivers or even 1/4" drive sockets will fit right in. TOOL KING is offering a cordless screwdriver for only \$9.95. There are assortments of nuts/bolts/washers or electrical terminal ends that will do endless duty around the house and car. Pliers have endless variety, everything from needle-nose to vise grips to side cutters to offset needle nose are available. There are sales that offer 2 or 3 vise grip sizes with another freebie thrown in. A garage can never have too many pair of vise grip pliers in every size and shape possible. There are also things like key fobs, decals and model cars available too.

GETTING AWAY from stocking stuffers, a great CORVAIR tool is a UNI-SYN. This aids in the synchronization of the multiple carbs on CORVAIR and also will work on PORSCHE, MG and other funny furrin' cars. There are certain tools that simply take a beating, things like roll pin punches, caping chisels (or any other chisel), drill bits and grinding stones/wire brushes.

If you (or your other half) marvels at the way air tools work when you are at the professional garage, look into a small air compressor. There are portable compessors that work from 110volt and are rated at 3-5 hp that will do great around the house. If you have ever found a low tire in the morning and lose lots of time changing to the spare, the convenience of having the compressor inside the garage is well worth the price. 
