

Corvair Price Guide contributed by Bill Reider

Here are the December 2000 prices of Corvairs from Old Cars Price Guide. If you want to check to see what your Corvair is worth, you will have to know what grade you car is and go from there.

Grade 1 is Excellent: Restored to current maximum professional standards of quality in every area, or perfect original with components operating and appearing as new. A 95-plus point show car that is not driven.

Grade 2 is Fine: Well-restored, or a combination of superior restoration and excellent original. Also, an extremely well maintained original showing very minimal wear.

Grade 3 is Very Good: Completely operable or older restoration showing wear. Also, a good amateur restoration, all presentable

and serviceable inside and out. Plus, combinations of well done restoration and good operable components or a partially restored car with all parts necessary to complete and/or valuable NOS parts.

Grade 4 is Good: A drivable vehicle needing no or only minor work to be functional. Also, a deteriorated restoration or a very poor amateur restoration. All components may need restoration to be excellent, but the car is mostly usable as is.

Grade 5 is Restorable: Needs complete restoration of body, chassis and interior. May or may not be running, but isn't weathered, wrecked or stripped to the point of being useful only for parts.

Grade 6 is a Parts Car.

ATTENTION COLLECTOR PLATE OWNERS

by Steve Goodman

On occasion at the shop someone asks me about checking their emissions levels because their COLLECTOR plates are coming due and they need a test.....or worse; they drive into the emissions testing businesses and ask for a test because their collector plates are due. GUESS WHAT emission testing facility will not ask you about the collector plates, they will simply run the test and charge the \$15.00.

HOWEVER remember that if you are simply renewing the plates at the end of the 5-year period NO NEW EMISSIONS TEST IS REQUIRED.

All you do is send money to the State of Colorado. In the beginning of the new emissions rules that we are now under, once passes the test the first time and gains the collector plates, no other test is required until the vehicle is sold OR the plates expire.

Depending upon the year and model, there are 11 to 13 different types of lamps used on Corvairs in 27 to 33 separate locations. If you want to carry "on-board spares" for the most critical applications, get the following:

1960 1 ca. #57, 1 ca. #67, 1 ca. #1034, 1 ca. #4001, 1 ca. #4002

1961 - 69 1 ca. #67, 1 ca. #1157, 1 ca. #1895, 1 ca. #4001, 1 ca. #4002

Of course you can carry more -- except for the headlights, they are small and lightweight.

- George MacMannis recommends 1077B instead of the 1157 for the tail lights available from Super Trak. Another alternative is WAGNER #2357, a 40 cp bulb to replace the stock 1157.
- ** These are hard to find. Most available have bulbs that are too fat. George MacMannis has found ones that fit at Pep Boys.

PAINTING A CARBURETOR -by- Mike Stickler, CORVAIRS OF NEW MEXICO

After cleaning a carburetor in carb cleaner the factory finish is removed in the process and you are left with an aluminum finish. The original finish on Spyder carburetors is black and on other carbs it is a gold or brassy finish. Ordinary paint will wash off with gasoline. Powder coating is expensive and may not be recommended due to the high temperature of the curing oven.


The best solution I have found is to paint the carb with "Hot Fuel Proof" paint found at hobby shops that sell gas powered model airplanes.

These paints may dry with a glossier finish than desired, so another tip is to flatten the finish with talcum powder. Sprinkle the talcum powder on the not-yet-dry paint and then wash it off when the paint is fully dry. The degree of flattening is adjusted by how soon you "dust" the paint after spraying. You can experiment on scrap pieces first to get the desired effect.

TECH TIP - Steering Gear Adjustment

Here's an adjustment that takes about ten minutes - on the car - without taking anything loose.

If you have excessive play in your steering wheel, and it's in the gearbox (usually it's the pitman arm bushing), here's what you can do:

With the wheels in the straight ahead position, rock the steering wheel back and forth, noting how much effort it takes to rock it. Now loosen the large lock nut around the "Worm Bearing Adjuster" nut with a hammer and screwdirver, and tighten the adjuster nut; just "snug". Then rock the wheel and "back up" the adjuster so that there is little or no change in the effort necessary to rock the wheel. Next, loosen the lock nut on the "Lash Adjuster" with a 9/16" wrench, and hold it while you turn in the adjustment with a screwdriver. It will turn easily, so when you reach the "snug" position, rock the wheel again and see that all the play has disappeared.

If the wheel is now hard to turn, back off the adjustment slightly, reaching the best compromise of ease-of-turning and lack-of-free-play. Tighten the lock nuts and check for steering gear fluid. Remove the filler plug and poke your little finger in there the check the level. If not up to the top (it won't be!), Fill it up. And since it's a secret in the shop manual, I used 140 weight gear oil. LES HUCKINS, CORSA WEST OF L.A.





Check For Exhaust Fumes

Corvair drivers and passengers are ordinarily kept warm in winter months by hot air coming off the engine. If the engine is clean and has no oil leaks or exhaust leaks, this heated air feels very good on cold days, but if the exhaust manifold is leaking, this warm air could be very dangerous because it could contain lethal carbon monoxide fumes.

A major exhaust leak is obvious, but minor leaks may not be noticed until the driver and passengers are unconscious.

For \$2.25, you can monitor the exhaust leaks in your Corvair and avoid the fatal effects of carbon monoxide gas coming from the heater. You can buy a small indicator that can be placed in view of the driver and that will possibly save your life. This indicator is normally light tan in color, but if carbon monoxide fumes are present, the indicator turns dark brown to black, depending on the amount of carbon monoxide that is present.

If you do find carbon monoxide fumes coming from your Corvair heater, here is a list of possible exhaust leak areas that could be causing the problem:

- 1. Leaking around the exhaust tubes to the cast iron exhaust manifold on each cylinder head. The packing rings could be deteriorated, or the wrong ones may have been used.
- 2. Leaking at a head gasket, allowing combustion gases to escape into the heater.
- 3. Leaking at the cylinder head where the steel exhaust tubes press into the aluminum head.
- 4. Missing or deteriorated engine sheet metal, particularly at the rear of the engine.
- 5. Perimeter seal around the entire engine, where it seals to the Corvair body. This seal is supposed to keep road dust, as well as exhaust gas, out of the engine compartment and therefore out of the heater.
- 6. Leaks between the exhaust pipe and manifolds. The packing rings could be deteriorated.
- 7. Leaks in the crossover pipe (if used) where the two headpipes join together.
 - 8. Tail pipe that ends before the outer body panel.
- 9. To a lesser degree, if the rear of the engine lid seal is leaking, exhaust fumes from the tail pipe can be sucked into the engine compartment and the heater, even if nothing in the exhaust system is leaking.

Inspect For Rusted Shrouds

As the years go by, the Corvair engine is experiencing a serious rust-out problem with engine lower shrouds. As some say, that can be just the tip of the iceberg.

The problem is quite serious on the right hand side of the engine because the #5 cylinder exhaust take-down stack is nearly against the shroud. There is an asbestos/fiberglass type fabric seal collar installed around the exhaust manifold. This seal was intended to deflect road water from entering the shrouds and putting steam into the heater system. This seal eventually goes away or is omitted when manifolds are replaced. Now you have some water on the hot shrouds and the rust accelerates. The lower shroud rusts away around the manifold, but even more quickly the front shroud rusts away (that's the piece that mounts the 4" heater hose). Now the #5 cylinder exhaust take-down gets the road water and it begins to rust away. Progressive deterioration rusts away the take-down flange, and also the manifold at the donut seal. Final result is an exhaust leak that can be picked up into the heater.

While doing engine re-seal jobs, I found two cases of this excessive rusting. The cure involves a new manifold and a new take-down stack (which is not easy to replace). Then the whole process starts again if the rusted shrouds and seals are not replaced. Good shrouds are not easy to find; rusted ones usually must be cut and new metal welded in. If you are going into the southwest area of our country and find good used shrouds, snap them up and return home with semi-treasures! (10/88)

Early Car Heater Improvement

While preparing my 1964 four-door for winter use, I remembered the weak heater/defroster (especially the defroster) of the early cars. There just never seems to be enough force of hot air where it is needed.

A simple way to increase the air flow to the front heater ducts and defroster outlets begins by temporarily removing the back seat. There you will find the heater hoses and ducts which channel the flow of hot air.

With the seat removed, turn the fan switch on high and push down the heat and air levers. You will probably feel a lot of air escaping from the duct work under the back seat. A fair amount of air is lost where the plastic duct stops behind the two metal heater flaps at the front of the back seat. I removed these two flaps with a Phillips screwdriver and taped both ends of the ducts shut. I also taped around all the joints where the hoses meet the ducts, to prevent any leaks.

After turning the heater fan back on, I checked for any leaks and then replaced the metal flaps and the bottom of the back seat. I noticed a greater volume of air coming out of both the front heater duct and the defrost outlet, and very seldom now use the fan while driving.

The only drawback is that the rear passengers will lose the heat at their feet, but since I use my '64 as a work vehicle, I primarily ride alone. It sure is nice to have a completely clear windshield rather than one with two defrosted half-moons. No sense in heating the rear seat springs anyway. (12/89)
