





VAIRS IN THE AIR - 1996

Just a brief overview of Albuquerque and the 1996 International CORSA Convention to be held June 18th through 22nd in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Albuquerque is situated in the Rio Grande valley at the foot of the Sandia and Manzano mountains. The altitude of Albuquerque varies between 5000 and 6000 feet because we are largely on the talus slope of the Sandia mountains which go up to about 10,800 feet.

Because of our altitude and low rainfall, daytime temperatures can be expected in the 80's or 90's during the day with a humidity usually below 30%. Night time temperatures usually drop into the high 60 to low 70 range and with the low humidity a light jacket is sometimes desired. A hat and sun screen is advisable during the day since at our altitude you can sunburn much quicker than at lower altitudes.

While in Albuquerque you might want to find time to visit some of the local attractions. The Old Town area was the original center of Albuquerque before the Santa Fe railroad came through. It is known for its shopping and restaurants. The Albuquerque Zoo is one of the best in the Southwest and is located in the bosque of the valley. There are two ways to go to the top of the Sandias. A paved two lane road goes up the east side to the top where there is a small restaurant and gift shop along with great views, or you can drive to the foot of the mountain on the west side and ride the tram to the top where there is another restaurant. The Petroglyph National Monument is on the west side of the city along the escarpment which is the remains of an old lava flow.

Since you are here, why not extend your vacation and visit some of the wonders of the Southwest which are within a days drive of Albuquerque. Carlsbad Caverns, White Sands, Bandelier National Monument and Mesa Verde National monument. and several other Indian ruins between. Ride the Cumbres and Toltec narrow gauge railroad, visit Taos, see the Very Large Array radio telescopes west of Socorro.

The host hotel is the Albuquerque Hilton. The room rate is \$75.00 per night and the phone number for reservations is (505)884-2500. We will also be

using rooms at the Fairfield Inn by Marriott where the room rate will be \$57.00 per night and their phone number is (505)889-4000. There has been some confusion due to two different hotels being listed in the CORSA Communiqu's Calendar. The Albuquerque Hilton is the host hotel and all meetings, vendor sales and the banquet will be held there. The Fairfield Inn is adjacent to the Albuquerque Hilton. These two hotels should be considered as one except for registering (that is for your room), rates and how room service is handled.

Also, if you plan on coming to the Convention in your RV, the nearest place to park is the Albuquerque Central KOA Kampground which is about 6 miles east on I-40 from the host hotel. The rates range from \$25.95 through \$29.95 and the phone number for reservations is 1-800-562-7781 and they do require reservations.

We have four tech sessions lined up. The subjects include turbos, CPF, the history of license plates (which I found extremely interesting) and fuel injection. Our tours will include trips to Santa Fe, Acoma Pueblo and along the Turquoise Trail. We've also lined up a Chuckwagon Dinner Party for Thursday night.

The Rally will be a Continental Rally as defined by CORSA with pictures and questions. The Econorun is a 70 mile scenic route using both city and rural roads and includes an historic trail and drive through an Indian reservation.

One of our members has donated a 1965 Monza Coupe which will be raffled off. The car is four-speed, air-conditioned with telescopic steering and no rust. A total of 5000 tickets will be sold at \$1.00 apiece beginning January 1, 1996. We will pre-sale 4000 tickets and reserve 1000 to be sold at the convention at a rate of 200 a day. The drawing will take place at the Awards Banquet on Saturday. You do not need to be present to win!

And finally, we're in the process of putting together a cookbook of recipes that have been contributed by CORSA members. At this time we have approximately 150 recipes but could always use a few more. I'll be accepting recipes through the end of the year. 

WHAT DO I CARRY IN THE FRONT OF MY CAR?

Garrie Fox asked me about my tool bag and parts pouches, two bags made from pants legs with draw stings. Since I own the shop, I guess I feel responsible to be able to take care of all the cars on the road. Electric fuel pump, valve springs and rockers, pushrods and tubes, oil press switch, idler pulley, point plate, alt bearings, bulbs, wire, tape, fuel and vac hose, springs, jets and rods and needle/seat for YH, plus similar parts for Roch HV, just about every gasket and seal for the powertrain, an assortment of nuts, bolts, cotter pins etc to fit various parts of the powertrain AS WELL AS tools to repair or replace any part that I carry. In addition, since two of the cars are German with Corvair engines I carry an assortment of metric hardware and tools too. I also have a 12V compressor, small floor jack and a spare axle with bearing for the '62.

NOTE: I have seldom used any of this for myself but occasionally find someone else in need.



TRI-STATE 20th ANNIVERSARY

Rocky Mountain Corsa of Denver will host the annual Tri-State Corvair meet in Montrose on May 10-12. The host motel is the Red Barn. Phone for reservations is (970) 249-4507 and room rate is \$38.00 for two. There are other motels as well as campgrounds in the area also.

This is a return to Montrose where 20 years ago the first meet was held. At that time it was to be a one time event, taking the place of driving all the way to Philadelphia for the national. The three clubs involved were Salt Lake City, Albuquerque and Denver hence the 'tri-state'.

In 1986 Albuquerque revived the meet with the suggestion that the hosting duties be rotated in the same manner as the Fan Belt Toss is done in Palm Springs each year. The meet was again held in Montrose and at the Red Barn, same as this year. Sadly the Utah club dropped out.

The slack was picked up by Pikes Peak Club in C Springs and even though there are only two states, the tri-state name has stuck. Every year Corvair owners from Oklahoma, California, Washington (state) and Iowa attend and every year the attendance seems to average about 100-110.

CORSA.....to join or not to join

The national club known as CORSA was started in 1971. It's obvious function was to gather all CORVAIR owners together. Clubs on a local level immediately began to form. In a lot of cases, the nucleus of the clubs were already started since the MONZA clubs sponsored by Chevy dealers had been a success in the sixties. Among the entertainment supplied by the local clubs were competition style events such as gymkhana, rally and autocross (later divided to include HI-SPEED) autocross. Naturally the thoughts of liability cropped up. It was fueled by stories of car clubs being sued by parking lot owners for pavement damage and even the time that the car club in question gave a "safety check" of each members' car, however later that day an already "checked" car was involved in an accident. Since that car had been "approved" suit followed that the car club was liable.

Consequently one of the best benefits that the parent club could offer the locals was a liability insurance policy. Sometime in the seventies the insurance carrier proposed that all local clubs affiliated with CORSA (actually called Chapters) have a 100% membership in the national club. The insurance company's stance was that since it covered all local club members, all said members should pay their share of the premium. The participating chapter clubs changed their by-laws to reflect that any local member must also be a member of national. There were some instances that members who only wanted to receive the local newsletter were called associate or in-active members. THEN—the requirement by the insurance carrier was dropped. A number of the chapter clubs then dropped the requirement also, although many left the by-laws alone.

Now the nineties are here!! National CORSA wants either 100% membership again OR the offending club will be assessed a fee of \$20.00 for various bookkeeping fees. So, should you join CORSA or not. If you attend a meeting or an event, the insurance coverage is there. When meets such as the TRI-STATE or even a tech session in John Koll's backyard are done, anyone who is a club member is covered. (This is not to replace any of your insurance, it covers each of us in the club against the type of litigation mentioned above). Actually, guests are covered too. If you are not a member of CORSA, you are getting a freebie.

ON THE OTHER HAND.....this is still a land of choice (even though it may be disappearing). There are members of PPCC that either have never attended an event or even a meeting in years. They apparently like reading the DRIPLINE and that is the total involvement that they are interested in. They also know that the invitation is always open to attend a function. Should they be forced to join an organization that they care nothing about?

Depending on your outlook, the cost of the national magazine COMMUNIQUE works out to just over \$2.00 per month. You cannot buy a car magazine for less than \$4.00 from the news stand. I also believe that CORSA should make one FINAL decision on the 100% rule and stick by it till the end.

HOWEVER, if the rule was made to go back to 100% participation, then national should turn that rule around and force anyone who lives in a zip code where a local chapter is located to join that local club. Lets face it, this is not about 100% participation of bodies, it is about MONEY!!!

I personally cannot understand what \$20.00 will do, the national club already knows those who are and are not members. The computer readout that was sent to PPCC was grossly inaccurate. It did not indicate a number of members who are CORSA members and that includes myself. If the fees are a ploy to raise revenue, CORSA should just raise the dues. In fact I understand that the budget is stretched. I will not find fault with this. The costs of doing business are raising all the time as I well know. CORSA is still one of least expensive car clubs to join. They should raise dues to a substantial dollar figure that will carry them for several years. The members will complain whether the dues are raised one dollar or ten, but those who are interested will still be a part of CORSA. Those who chose not to should look at the other national club dues.

That last statement, the part about those who are interested will stay and let the others go, is really the crux of this whole article. Should those members who are not really interested in attending more than an occasional function be forced to join, should PPCC as a club be forced to contribute \$20.00 into nationals coffers because we are not 100%. My personal answer to both questions is NO NO NO. National had their chance to keep clubs at 100% and they blew it!

I hope they will cash my check for renewal in Jan 97.



ANOTHER SOLUTION FOR NO REVERSE

Four speed Corvairs are notorious for 'losing' reverse. Actually it isn't lost, worn shift linkage parts just make it darn difficult to find. HOWEVER, I discovered another way to 'misplace' reverse. A customer had replaced a head on his early convert and after dropping the car to the driveway found 4 forward and NO backing up. I went through the normal motions of checking shift coupler/pin, then to the front and checked the bushing under the shift tower and all are in good shape. Using a screwdriver the reverse detent could be felt but it was not moving all the way over into reverse. Finally I noticed that the backup lite switch (which has no wires, just working as a plug) was pretty clean. Asking him if he did anything to the switch he said he tightened it up because of leaking gear grease. I unloosened the switch a turn and presto! REVERSE! Using another used gasket ring under the switch/plug lowered the switch and allowed the shift rail to move as nature (and GM) intended.

MONEY MAKING SUGGESTIONS

At the October meeting a couple of ideas to help add to our treasury were discussed. One was the volunteering of members to help at the Renaissance Festival next summer. The other was our own phone cards using PPCC advertisements. After talking to President Larry Neal, I decided to suggest another. The only benefit of this idea is that we can have fun with our cars while doing it.

A new position has to be created for the job, sort of a PR man or person. This person ideally would be acquainted with the business community of C Springs and be able to go into the shopping centers and arrange for a mall show for our Corvairs. The selling points are easy: probably the most famous and infamous of American cars sitting in the mall; staffed by the most knowledgeable people to answer questions (us) and best of all, with advertising by the mall the buying public will come to see the cars and buy in the stores. This PR type could also be beneficial in getting our cars into parades and advertising situations.

The advertising budgets of the malls could easily pay for 10-15 cars for a weekend. Marcia Shuck arranged for one at the Bluffs several years ago and it was quite successful.

Think about it, volunteer if you think you would like to be a part of this venture. We will maybe talk about it more at the November meeting.

STORING YOUR CAR AND TODAY'S GASOLINE

Recently the new gasolines have presented curious problems to folks storing cars for a period of time. I have noticed a large number of filler neck hoses failed (read ROTTED) and also the connector hose at the back over the rear axle tying the body fuel line to the engine fuel line will be extremely hard and usually cracked. AT THE SAME TIME, the short hose that connects the tank with the line towards the rear of the car is NOT showing the same deterioration.

My best guess is that the hoses that are cracking and otherwise turning to poo-poo are doing so because they are allowed to dry out. The bottom hose from the tank is always wet on the inside (unless the tank is empty).

Likewise inside the carbs, the accel pump will be hard as a rock after sitting dry, the diaphram on a Carter side draft will actually break allowing fuel to run right through it. Probably this is a cause of failure on mechanical fuel pumps too.

The only answer that I can come up with is to start your cars through the period of storage. For most of us it is through the winter months. If the car is started and allowed to run for 20-30 minutes and during that time moved back and forth or out into the driveway, the bearings and even the brake system is used and kept in working condition. Also keep your fuel tanks full, maybe add some alcohol to absorb the moisture too. Do not just start your engine for a couple of minutes, the chokes will stay on and the fuel will get into the oil and contaminate it, also will wash the cylinder walls with excess fuel. Warm the engine up thoroughly.


NEW MEMBERS

SMELLY HEATER

If you have really worked at fixing those pesky oil leaks but are still getting a faint whiff of oil/exhaust/just plain stinky in the car, check these little places. The gasket inside the oil filler cap, cap should turn very tightly. If edge of cap has oil, gasket is leaking or cap is not tight. Next is vent tube, there is an o-ring around the tube, if it is hard or non-existent, blow-by fumes will pass directly into the cooling fan and immediately into the heater system. Got a smell you can't quite place? Might be the battery is overcharging, usually the fault of the regulator. If the battery has moisture on top or the left carb and adjoining area are whitish and pock marked, look to battery acid. Another source of curious smells is a mouse, usually stuck on top of the oil cooler. Take the oil cooler cover off and discover what is stuck there. Happens in the winter time mostly. Also if a leaky differential side seal throws a drop back on the exhaust, the smell of burning gear lube is terrible. It is right under the heater shrouds, sure to come into the car.
